

MESSAGE FROM THE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR, HUON GULF DISTRICT

To the people of Huon Gulf District,

It is my honor to address you and share important updates on the progress and development taking place across our district.

With the support of our Member, Honorable Jason Peter, we have embarked on a transformative journey to improve services and infrastructure throughout our 65 ward council areas, spanning the three Local Level Governments—Wampar, Salamaua, and Morobe.

From early 2023 to September 2024, the Huon Gulf District Development Authority (HGDDA), under Honorable Peter's leadership, has committed and allocated District Support Improvement Program (DSIP) funds to drive this change. His vision is clear: to make Huon Gulf District a beacon of development within Morobe Province, guided by the "Bottom-Up Planning Strategy"—ensuring that services begin at the grassroots level and reach every ward.

We envision Huon Gulf as a "Morning Star"—a district rising with new energy, purpose, and progress. The District Administration, HGDDA, and Team JP are working hand in hand to realize this vision and uplift the livelihoods of our people.

For the first time in our district—and possibly in Morobe Province and Papua New Guinea—DSIP funds have been allocated directly to LLG Presidents and Ward Councilors to implement projects within their respective wards. This bold decision by Honorable Peter empowers local leadership and ensures that development is community-driven and inclusive.

Each of our three LLGs—Wampar, Salamaua, and Morobe—has received K1 million, while each of the 65 wards has been allocated K100,000. These funds are being used to implement vital projects that respond to the needs of our communities.

I encourage you to take note of the progress in your respective areas and remain engaged in the development process. Together, we are building a new Huon Gulf District—one that reflects the aspirations and strength of its people.

Thank you and may our journey forward continue with unity and purpose.
